Checklist of Documents

- Copy of current stable insurance document with a minimum \$2,000,0000 commercial liability coverage. If your insurance expires mid-year, please include a copy of the current policy and forward a copy of the future term policy when it is renewed.
- Facilities membership application accompanied by completed accreditation checklist & undertaking (Appendix B & C).
- Must be a current adult OE member.
- Emergency action plan, stable rules, policies and/or procedures (should be posted in a public area of the stable).
- Copy of stable rules.
- Acknowledgment of stable's liability waiver.

Member Stable Application Checklist

Please initial each box to confirm you have read/provided the information and your stable complies with what the standard as described OR mark N/A if the standard is not applicable to your stable (i.e. if you do not offer coaching).

- A. Children under the age of 7 will ride on a lead line until the supervising coach is satisfied that they are capable to ride independently
- B. I understand that Ontario Equestrian requires that at least one equestrian coach is licensed and or NCCP certified
- C. Supervision
 - Riders under the age of 14 should not be at a riding stable without supervision
 - Riders under the age of 17 should not be at the riding stable without the consent of a parent/guardian
 - No beginner rider should be riding without supervision
- D. All riders must wear safety vests when riding and/or jumping a cross-country eventing course
- E. Indoor and outdoor riding arenas are securely fenced with a gate, free of obstructions (farm equipment, etc), footing regularly harrowed
- F. Adequate lighting
- G. The location of safety equipment are prominently marked and noted on the stable's on Emergency Action Plan
- H. Plans for the storage and disposal of animal waste
- I. Safe and secure storage of medications
- J. Safe Riding Trails including requirement for riders to sign out and in when on the trail, trails clear of obstructions, properly marked, access available in the event of an emergency, riders to be equipped with cell phone or two-way radio while on the trail
- K. Paddocks should be safely enclosed and gated, with access to fresh water
- L. Tack
 - Must be regularly cleaned and checked that it is safe and in proper working condition
 - Must fit the horse it is used with
 - Must be checked at the beginning of any lesson
- M. Schooling Lesson Horses
 - Minimum age is determined by local by law regulations and the stable's insurance provider
 - Should not be stallions
 - Should not be used in riding lessons beyond a 6:1 ratio of horses/students to coach
 - Should not be used for 24 hours after receiving inoculations
 - Should not be used when they show signs of lameness or injury
 - Should be properly trained, with skills and temperament suited to the level of a rider being coached.
 - Should be mounted using a mounting block and with the direct supervision of a coach, guide or assistant
- N. Maximum one rider per horse
- O. Riders participating in a trail ride should be a minimum of 10 years of age or, when between the ages of 6 and 9, should be individually supervised.
- P. There should be a minimum of two trail guides of over four persons, not to exceed six persons, at which point a further guide will be required for every additional five persons
